HYER CAFETERIA NEWS!

The Hyer PTA has run and operated the Hyer Cafeteria since 1949! The tradition of PTA-sponsored lunch programs is as old as the HPISD itself. It started in 1914 when Armstrong opened as the first HPISD school without a cafeteria and moms volunteered to go up to school and heat soup for students during the lunch hour. This tradition of PTA provided lunches has passed to each successive school opened in the HPISD and continues strong today at Hyer! When your student purchases lunch from the Hyer Cafeteria, your family is supporting the operations of the Hyer Cafeteria, which in turn allows us to continue having an incredible cafeteria staff as



well as delicious, healthy food selections for our students! Thank you for supporting the Hyer Cafeteria!

Prices

Lunches will be priced as follows:

Grade K-1 hot or cold boxed lunches with milk, juice or water - \$4.75

Grade K-1 hot or cold boxed lunches with organic milk - \$6.25

Grade 2-4 hot or cold boxed lunches with milk, juice or water - \$5.25

Grade 2-4 hot or cold boxed lunches with organic milk - \$6.75

Payment

Cash will not be accepted in the cafeteria at this time. Please ensure that you have added funds to your child's account before the first day of school on Wednesday, August 18.

How to add funds to your student's lunch account:

- 1. Log into **eFunds for Schools** using your Skyward login information.
- 2. Click "Fund Lunch" under the "Make a Payment" tab. First-time users will be required to enter payment information.
- 3. Select the student whose account you wish to fund and follow the step-by-step instructions to make a payment.
- Click "Submit" and wait for confirmation.

We suggest you enable account balance notifications so that you are aware when your student's balance is running low. You may also automatically replenish your student's balance. Please click "Low Meal Balance Settings" under "Payment Settings" and follow the steps to complete the process.

Hyer cafeteria staff and administration do not have access to your Skyward passwords or financial information. Should you need to reset your password, please click **HERE** more detailed instructions.

Negative Balance Policy

As a reminder, the cafeteria offers the cafeteria account payment option as a convenience to students and parents and, in turn, asks that parents help support the cafeteria's efforts to keep a balanced budget by keeping their student's cafeteria account balance positive at all times. The first time a student's cafeteria account reaches an actual balance of negative \$25, the account will be closed until payment is made. The second time a student's cafeteria account reaches an actual balance of negative \$25, the account will be permanently closed for the remainder of the school year. Failed payments (i.e., bounced or returned payments) will not be counted towards determining actual account balances under this policy.

Volunteers

By volunteering in the cafeterias in the HPISD, parents save our district over \$400,000. Cafeteria volunteers are essential in helping our cafeteria run smoothly and feed our nearly 500 students!

At Hyer, we typically utilize 370 volunteers every month. With 360 families this year, we need every family to volunteer to keep our Hyer Cafeteria running efficiently! 
CELEBRATE YOUR HUSKIES WITH BACK TO SCHOOL BALLOONS AND SUPPORT HYER

CITY OF UNIVERSITY PARK CONSTRUCTION UPDATE



Hillcrest between Bryn Mawr and Greenbrier closed to all traffic

By the end of August, construction is scheduled to be completed for the segment that includes the intersection of Turtle Creek and Southwestern. The installation of the box culverts in the 3400 block of Southwestern is nearing completion. Paving of that block will continue through the

fall. Weather permitting, the Hillcrest closures will last for approximately 12 months as work progresses north a block at a time between Southwestern and Colgate. To alert motorists, digital message boards have been positioned on Hillcrest at Northwest Highway and at Lovers Lane. Prior to the start of the 2021-22 school year, the City will work with HPISD to communicate the impact these closures will have on campus populations.
